

Instructions:

Add all ingredients except cornmeal into a bowl and mix well. Stir in cornmeal, adding more if necessary to form a firm mixture that will hold together. Form mixture into 8-12 patties and place on a parchment lined baking sheet. Bake in a 350°F oven for 15-20 minutes or until starting to brown. Serve warm with sour cream and pickled beets.
